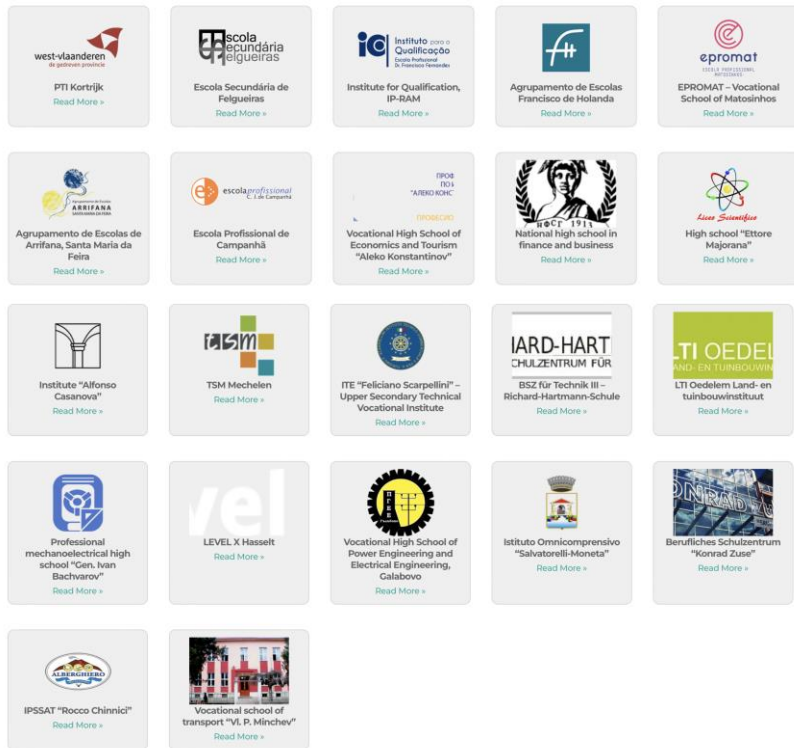
Main objectives

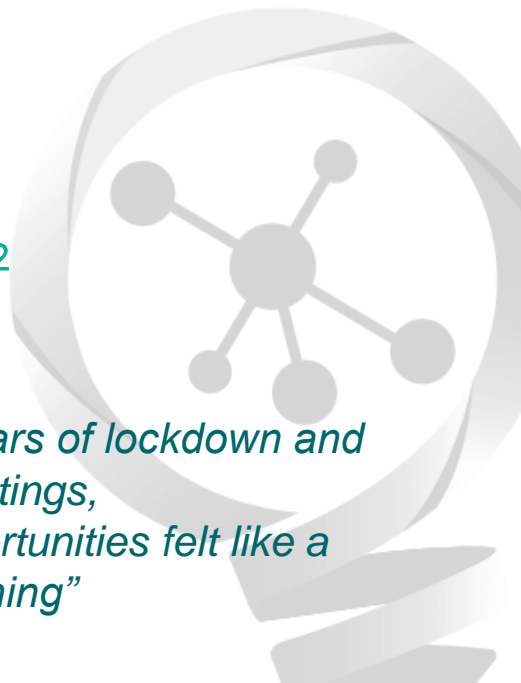
