

European Approach to Micro-credentials -Objectives

- Micro-credentials certify the learning outcomes following a small learning experience (flexible, targeted way to help people)
- Enable more people to acquire skills and competences they need to thrive in a changing labour market and society
- **Support the preparedness of providers** of micro-credentials (also VET providers) to empower people to forge personalised learning and career pathways
- Foster inclusiveness and equal opportunities



Micro-credentials - Scope

- Micro-credentials are not new. The Council Recommendation establishes a common European approach to the ongoing and emerging provision of micro-credentials
- Scope covers micro-credentials, as well as their policies that can support their effective **design** and **use**.
- EU approach does not seek to replace or disrupt existing systems or qualifications
